

## Proclamation Mayor Tim Kabat City of La Crosse

WHEREAS, great public schools are essential to a thriving community with a high quality of life; and

WHEREAS. La Crosse has a proud history of supporting its schools, dating to 1851, even before the city itself was incorporated; and

WHEREAS, the School District of La Crosse serves a population of nearly 80,000, extending beyond the borders of the city to all or parts of the neighboring towns of Medary, Shelby, Campbell, Bergen, Greenfield, Hamburg and Washington; and

WHEREAS, the District has nearly 1,000 employees serving almost 7,000 students in elementary, middle and high schools, including high-quality alternative and charter schools; and
